



Special Economic Zones in Poland

Special economic zones (SEZ) are areas of land designated as having special conditions attaching to investments made into these areas. The zones are designed to bring together the needs of investors and the needs of the particular region in which the special economic zone is located.

Investors conducting their activity in the area of SEZ are entitled to benefit from public aid made available in a number of ways, including, income tax exemptions. These investment incentives are offered to encourage job creation. The extent of the investment incentives depends on the particular zone, the amount of investment, number of jobs created, as well as several other criteria.

Currently, there are 14 special economic zones which are to exist until 31 December 2020 (after the recent extension of the time limits by the Regulations of the Council of Ministers):

1. Kamiennogórska SEZ
2. Pomorska SEZ
3. Katowicka SEZ
4. Słupska SEZ
5. Kostrzyńsko – Słubicka SEZ
6. Starachowice SEZ
7. Krakowski Park Technologiczny
8. Suwalska SEZ
9. Legnicka SEZ
10. Tarnobrzaska SEZ
11. Łódzka SEZ
12. Wałbrzyska SEZ
13. Mielec SEZ
14. Warmińsko-Mazurska SEZ

Recent amendment to the Act on Special Economic Zones on 4 August 2008, increased the area of the zones from 12,000 to 20,000 hectares (almost a 70% increase). These changes are designed to encourage further investment into the already successful zones.
